



July was a busy month for outreach to our Zwingli community and beyond. Although, at the time of this report, some of the Sunshine Team members had not reported their activities. Sue Sinnett shared a bag of peaches with thirteen individuals and couples. We appreciate these gifts she shared with our members and the wider community.

Prayer Chain: Weekly emails (x 5) to 22 Zwingli Members (plus one who receives a hard copy) on Prayer Chain, includes prayer requests for people who are ill, injured, undergoing surgery, Search Committee, etc. The number of people on our Prayer Chains and Sunshine Team emails have been increasing.

CD Distribution: 8 CDs distributed to four people who are homebound or in assisted living facilities.

Birthday/Anniversary Cards: Cinda Field sent 13 birthday cards and 4 anniversary cards on behalf of Zwingli UCC this month.

Visits: There were 27 visits made in July. This included visits made by Sue Sinnett delivering peaches and delivering Worship Service CDs.

Cards: The Sunshine Team sent 22 cards in July. Types of cards included birthday, sympathy, thinking of you, etc.

Phone Calls: The Sunshine Team made two phone calls in July.

Community Dinners: Hosts/Hostesses for Zwingli's July Community Dinner were Don and Suzy Halvorsen and Don and Mary Roe. We served 50 people. I believe this may be one of the highest attended dinners in recent history. The August Dinner is being planned by the Zwingli Chime Choir.


We will be celebrating during the Worship Service with a short slide show highlighting the good works of the many volunteers in our Church community.


